CLEMATIS

(TK horticultural name)

One of the most charming and colorful of all climbing plants, your new clematis vine will grace a sunny window with showy white blossoms for up to three months, and then continue to grow in your garden. Just follow these simple care instructions to keep your plant healthy and full of blooms. And, enjoy this gift with the warm wishes of the thoughtful person whose name appears on the address label.

PLACEMENT

Remove the packaging material and water your plant immediately. Place it in an indoor spot with bright indirect sunlight and cool temperatures, or in a shady location outdoors. Indoors, keep the container on a protected surface to prevent water damage to furniture.

WATER AND FERTILIZER

Keep the soil evenly moist, but not soggy. To water, remove your clematis and nursery pot from the decorative outer container. Set the plant in the sink and water well. Allow the plant to drain before returning it to its outer container.

TRANSPLANTING

Your clematis can be planted in a garden location that's well protected from hot midday sun. Remove the plant from its nursery pot, keeping the root ball intact. Plant with a mixture of garden soil and compost or commercial planting mix and water well. Apply a 1"-2" layer of mulch around the base of the plant to keep roots cool. As it grows, your clematis can be trained to cover a nearby fence or trellis. If planted beneath a taller shrub, it will wander up and weave its bright blossoms through the shrub. We recommend feeding your plant with an acid fertilizer every two weeks during the growing season.

PRUNING

Blooms will appear each year on new growth, so prune your garden clematis back in late winter before new growth starts.
