# GRAND TRUMPET™ AMARYLLIS

(*Hippeastrum species*)

Your new amaryllis is ready to sprout up and unfurl its spectacular blooms in just four to six weeks. Just follow these easy-care instructions for a healthy plant and flowers that will last for up to a month. And enjoy your living gift with the warm wishes of the thoughtful person whose name appears on the outer address label.

## PLACEMENT

Set your amaryllis where temperatures remain as close as possible to 65°-75° F and out of direct sunlight. Once the plant is in full bloom, its flowers will last longer if it is moved to a cool spot (55°-65° F) at night. Remember to turn your amaryllis regularly to keep stems from leaning toward the light source. Always place the container on a protected surface to prevent water damage to furniture.

## WATER

Remove packing material covering the top of the container and add water until soil feels moist. After this, your amaryllis will need very little water – just enough to keep the soil moist, but not soggy. Water more frequently once leaves and buds appear.

## TRANSPLANTING

After the blooms have faded, cut the stalk off 1"-2" above the bulb, being careful not to disturb the foliage. The leaves will continue to grow and nourish the bulb for reblooming next year. Continue watering and apply fertilizer occasionally, as you would for any potted plant. In the fall or when leaves start to wither, discontinue watering, trim off old leaves and store the plant in a cool place (45°-55° F). Approximately six weeks before blooms are desired, return your amaryllis to room temperature and begin watering – lightly at first until growth is observed, then normally, to keep soil moist.
