MANDEVILLA
(Mandevilla splendens)

A native of Brazil, this enchanting vining plant is ready to brighten your home with bright, trumpet-shaped blossoms. Just follow these simple instructions to keep your plant healthy and blooming until summer's end. And, enjoy your living gift with the warm wishes of the thoughtful person whose name appears on the outer address label.

PLACEMENT

Indoors, place your plant where it will receive a minimum of three hours of lightly filtered sunlight each day, and where temperatures remain within 60° F and 90° F. Since mandevillas prefer moist conditions, we recommend you increase humidity around your plant by misting it frequently or setting it on a tray of pebbles that are kept partially covered with water. Be sure to keep the tray or plant container on a protected surface to prevent water damage to furniture.

WATER AND FERTILIZER

During March through November, water regularly to keep soil moist to the touch, but not soggy. Allow soil to dry only slightly between waterings. Never allow your plant to sit in water. Water less frequently during winter, so that soil is kept from completely drying out. Fertilize during spring and summer with a commercial plant food, according to the product label instructions.

TRANSPLANTING

Your mandevilla may be transferred to a larger pot as it grows, and can be moved to a partially shady spot outdoors during the summer months.

PRUNING

Pruning, beginning in early spring, just after new growth starts, and continuing during the growing season, will produce a bushier plant. Flowers are borne on new growth, so don't prune back all the developing branches. If desired, long branches may be supported on a stake or trellis.
