PAPERWHITES
(Narcissus species)

Your paperwhite bulbs are ready to begin sprouting up into a bounty of cheerful, sweet-smelling blooms, sure to brighten even the grayest of winter days. Just follow these simple instructions and you'll have a big, fragrant bouquet in just three to four weeks. Please enjoy your living gift with the warm wishes of the thoughtful person whose name appears on the shipping address label.

UPON ARRIVAL

Carefully unpack the shipping carton and lift the container out by its rim, taking care not to disturb the bulbs' tender shoots. Sprouts may first appear yellow or pale green, but with your care, sunlight and water they will turn green in a few days.

PLACEMENT

Keep your planter of bulbs in a cool, bright location. Be sure to place the container on a protected surface to prevent water damage to furniture. Turn the container occasionally to keep stems from leaning too far toward the light.

WATER

Water regularly to keep soil moist but not soggy.

TRANSPLANTING

If you would like to save your bulbs for reblooming next season, follow these simple steps:

- Remove flower heads as they fade, keeping leaves and stems intact.
- After the foliage dies back (leaves will wilt and lose their color), stop watering and store bulbs in a cool dry location.
- In the fall, plant the bulbs two inches deep in a pot filled with potting soil.
- Place the pot in a cool, sunny location.
